## Maritime Update May 2020

- 1. Phase one of the Mill Dam Marina restoration is near completion.
  - -Re-decking of marina is complete.
  - -15 new finger floats have been installed that are servicing 30 vessels.
  - -Use of Frog Hooks have been eliminated from the Mill Dam Marina.
  - -New fire extinguishers and new cabinets have been installed around the marina.
  - -New and re-purposed electric pedestals have been installed throughout the marina, all four floats will have new electric pedestals installed by early June.
  - -A bid for a new stadium type comfort station at Mill Dam Marina has been awarded.
- 2. -Delivery of new sanitary pump out boat was taken in late March.
  - -All pump out stations are operational.
  - Pump outs boats are expected to be deployed for Memorial Day weekend beginning Friday May 22 barring any changes from the Supervisor's office.
- 3. All patrol vessels have been serviced in house and boats have been commissioned.
- 4. Beach Maintenance is ongoing.
- Maritime was awarded \$100,000 from EOSPA for new playground apparatus at Gold Star Beach.
- 6. -The \$125,000 awarded from EOSPA to Maritime for new playground apparatus is on hold until the Covid-19 situation subsides. Installation of the playground is anticipated for 2021.
  - 7. The Maritime team is moving forward with DEC permits for possible transient docking at the Town dock for the 2021 summer.
  - 8. The Covid-19 epidemic has put a number of projects on hold, such as the new visitor center.
